We are super excited to continue to get to know each other this year!

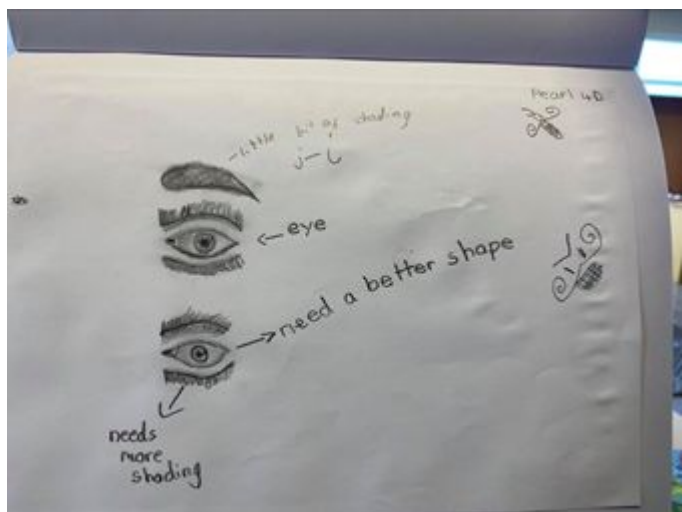
PHYSICAL EDUCATION & HEALTH

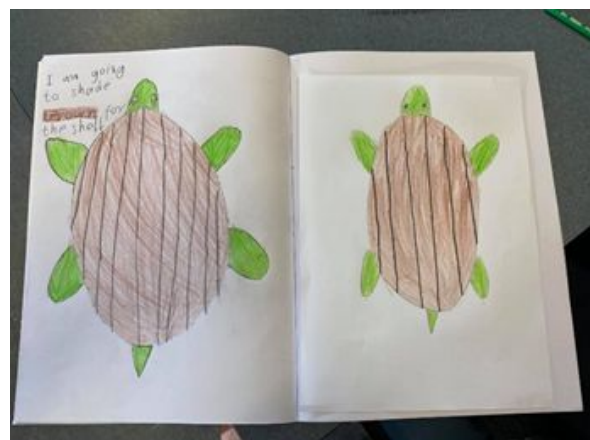

Visual Arts Vibe

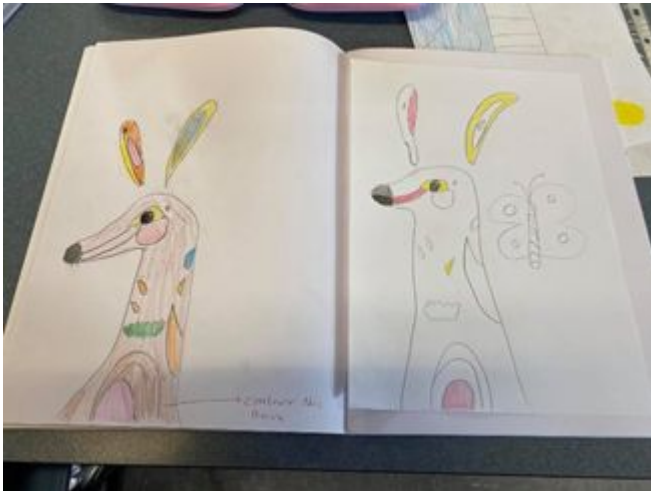

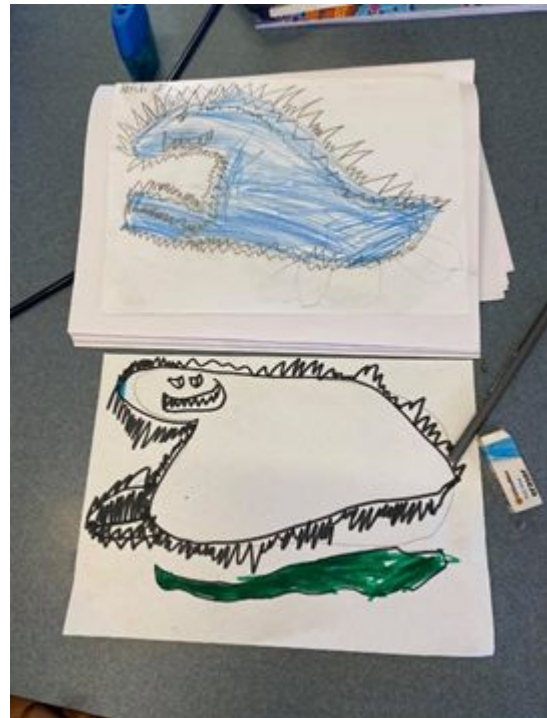
