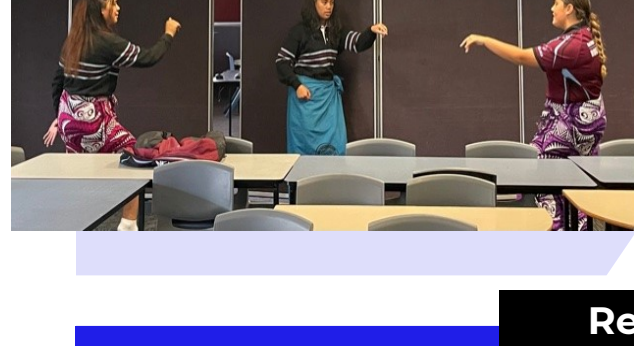


Dance Clubs

Renee's Classroom Visits

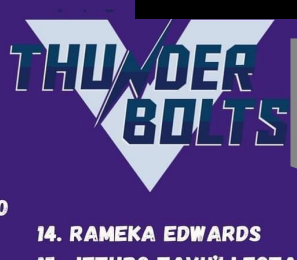

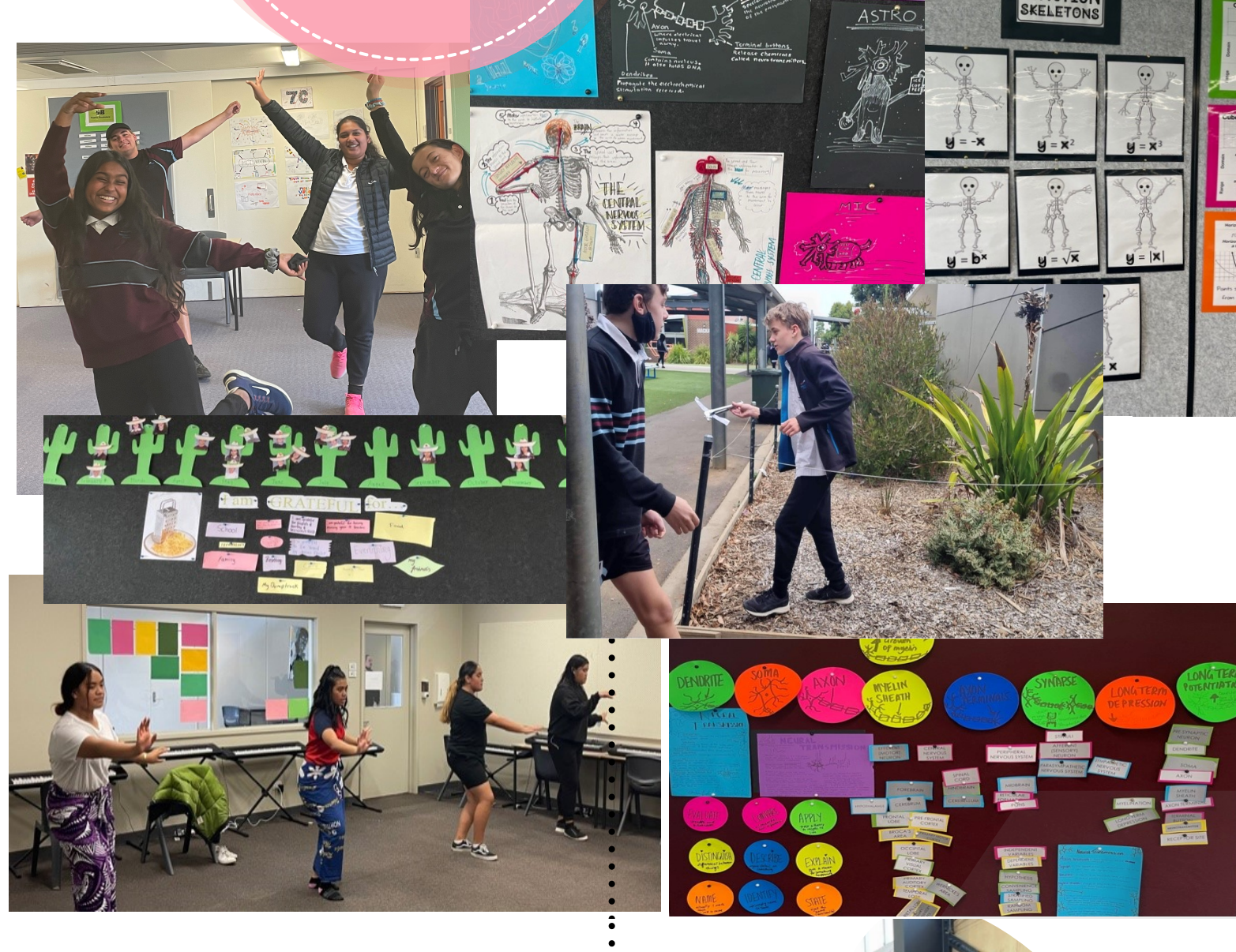
